General Information Automatically Collected and Stored:

Like most web sites you enter, MyIrishAncestry automatically gathers certain usage information like the numbers and frequency of visitors to our Web Site. Our system automatically stores your computer's Internet Protocol (IP) address (this is not your email address); the domain from which you access the Internet (e.g. "eircom.net" or "oceanfree.net"); the Internet address of the web site, if any, from which you came to our site; the date and time you arrived at our site and how long you spent on the site; and which pages you visited.

We only use such data in the aggregate. This collective data helps us determine how much our visitors use certain parts of the site, so we can improve our site to assure that it is as appealing as we can make it for as many of you as possible. We also may provide aggregated statistical "ratings" information, never information about you personally, to third parties for the purpose of reporting the sites success rate.
